

Instruction Manual Mobile BlueFox System







1 Alarm light of the Alarmbox When an alarm is released, the siren generates an acoustic and visual alarm. (The wrist unit is blocked after an alarm release and the red LED starts flashing, see instruction manual for wrist computer BlueFox). The Alarm light flashes also, when there is a problem with the connection of the receiving sensor, check connection. (see No. 3

LED Signals)

2 Charging-jack To load the Alarm Box battery

Attention: Charge the unit only outside the swimming pool area

3 LED Signals LED red Battery empty, needs to be charged

LED green O.K., Battery is charged

(see separate LED instruction)

4 Key Switch When starting the Alarm Box the key switch needs to be turned to

Pos. 1, if necessary remove the key. To switch of the Alarm Box turn

the key switch to Pos. 0.

5 Connector socket Connect **5a** to the receiving sensor socket **5b**. (Connection between

Alarm Box and underwater sensor).

Attention: After attaching the socket make sure to secure the

connection with the swivel.

6 Receiving Sensor + suction cup mount

The suction cup mount with the underwater sensor needs to be placed at 2/3 of water depth at the deepest point of the pool on the pool wall or

on the bottom of the pool.(see above illustration).

7 Test Unit

After the installation of the system the test unit needs to be placed in the water (approx.. 20 cm deep). The transmission of the signal underwater will be tested. The siren flashes if the transmission is successful..

Attention: There will be NO acoustic Alarm.

8 Automatic Charger

The Alarm Box Battery can be charged with the Automatic Charger.

Please see separate instructions

Attention: Charge the unit only outside the swimming pool area

9 Air Vent

While charging, the valve needs to be open. Please remove the red

plug completely. After charging fit the plug back into the Alarmbox.


The Mobile Unit BlueFox is now ready for use. You can use this unit only in connection with the BlueFox Monitoring Bracelet.



1 Water Contacts The Monitoring Bracelet switches on automatically when

immersed in water (through the 2 golden water contacts)

2 LED Signals

LED red (2 a) (1x flash Interval)

Battery empty, needs to be charged

LED red (2 a) (2x flash Interval) An Alarm has been triggered. The programmed parameters depth and time have been exceeded. The Monitoring

Bracelet remains locked and needs to be reset with the Download Box through the PC/Laptop. (see separate manual about

LED)

LED green (2 b) Monitoring Bracelet is ready for use

3 Download /Charger

In order to charge the battery or download new parameters you need to mount the download box on the backside of the monitoring bracelet. To download the software and reset the Alarm use the software program on our website: www.bluefox-poolsafety.com

4 Connection Contact for the charging connection for the download box/charger

(magnetic contact)

5 Connection USB small Connection for the download box/charger

6 Connection USB big Connection for the power plug/communication to PC/Laptop)

7 Power Plug For Battery charging unit

Attention: Charge the unit only outside the swimming pool area

Attention:: From time to time clean the water contacts with a Q-tip

and alcohol
